Paying homage to Frank Lloyd Wright's hemicycle floor plan with intersecting arcs and circles, Erik Peterson AIA, a Taliesin intern and ASU graduate, created the design inspired by her dreams for the site, and space for her unique collection of glass.

The outward curve of the home focuses on views across the pool out to the valley below, while hugging the backyard and creating a peaceful shelter. The roof design is sloped low on the southern exposure protecting the interior from the sun's harsh rays, sloping up along the north allowing for natural light to flood the interiors- perfect lighting for her glass.

"This is by far one of our most interesting homes to be completed this year, and will be an eye-catcher for sure," Peterson says.
