

How to Care for Your Swimwear

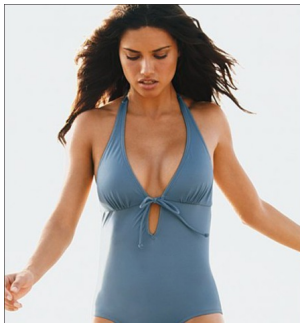
