Friday:



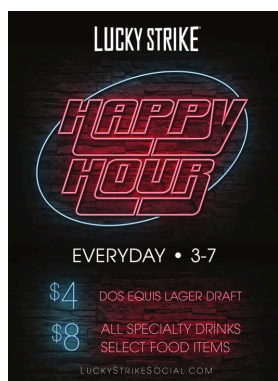
First Friday at The Nash

Live Music at Desert Ridge Marketplace

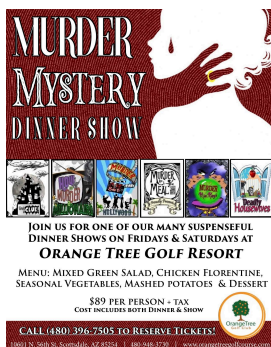

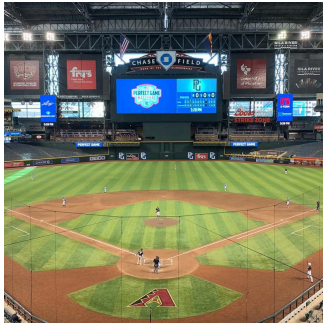
Instructor, Student and Staff Exhibition at Shemer Art Center
