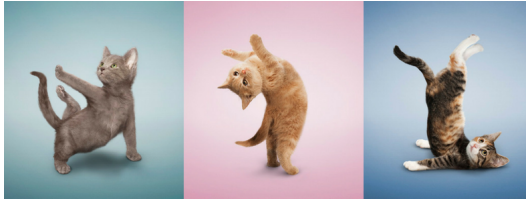
My Little Pumpkin 3rd Annual Fall Festival
