Tercero by Aldea Weddings

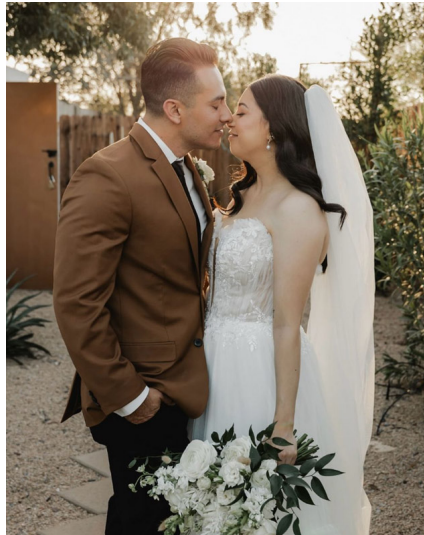
