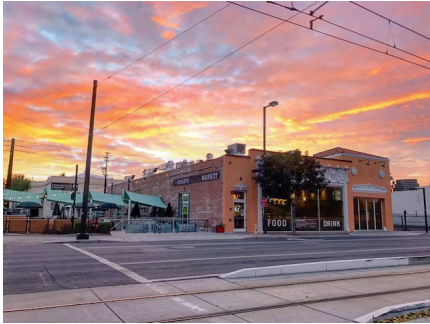

Barks & Brews

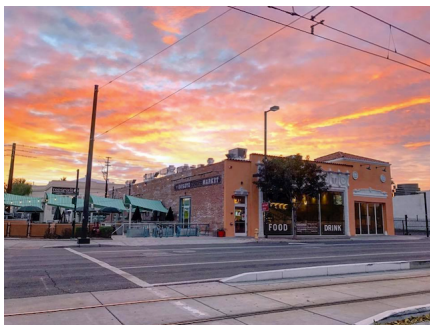
