

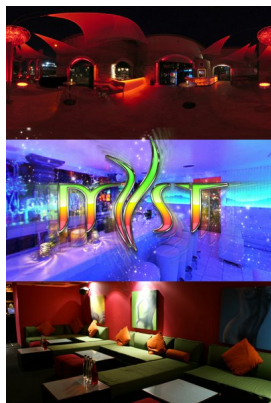
YouTube Sensation Is In The Spotlight
